Purpose

The purpose of this report is for Council to finalise the projects for Council's applications under the Bushfire Local Economic Recovery Fund (BLERF).

Background

At Council workshops held in November and December 2020, Council endorsed three projects to be investigated as potential projects for funding through the Bushfire Local Economic Recovery Fund. These included:

- 1. Community Hub Building;
- 2. Lions Park Upgrade; and
- 3. Skate Park upgrade.

Council staff have prepared concepts and draft applications for these projects. Closing time and date for applications is 2pm Thursday, 28 January 2021.

Report

At councillor workshop held Friday, 22 January 2021, the following outcomes were supported for each project:

- 1. Community Hub Building additional work required to review business case and project specific community consultation. Project to be developed further as a concept and not submitted as part of the BLERF.
- 2. Lions Park Upgrade project endorsed for submission in the BLERF
- 3. Skate Park upgrade project endorsed for submission in the BLERF, with scope to be expanded to consider the costs of installation of CCTV cameras and the site with relevant supporting systems.
